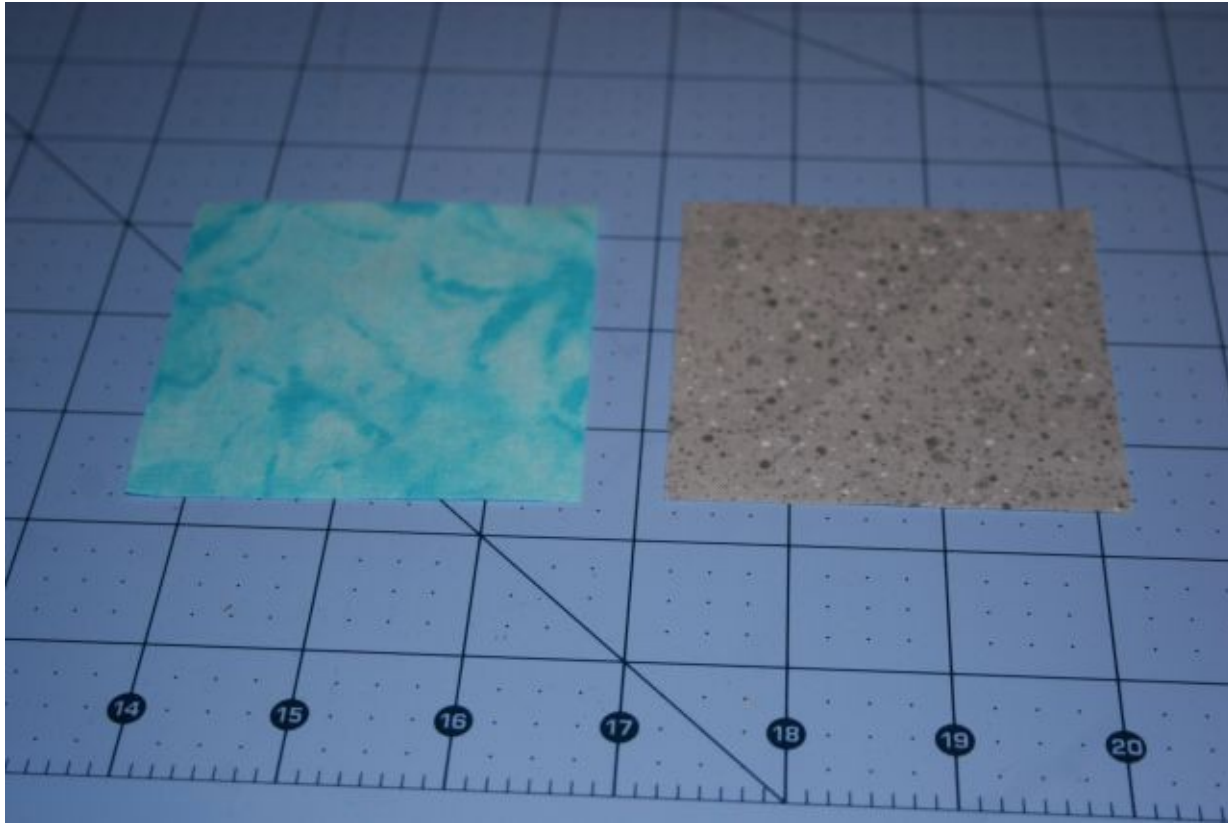


Clue#5

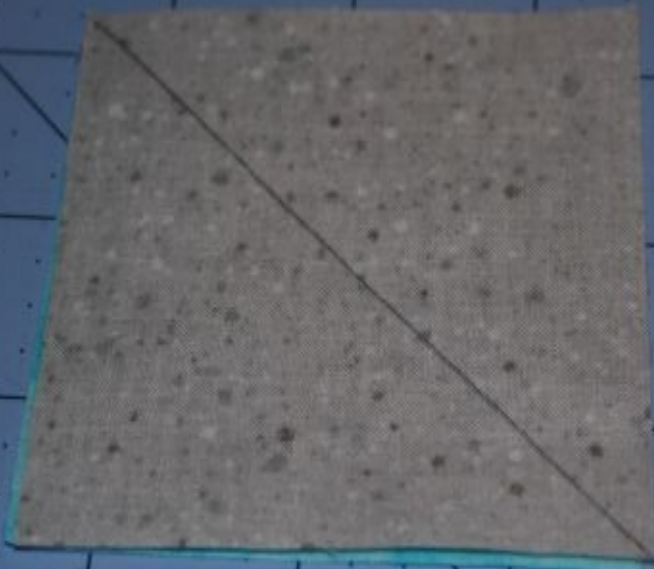


Supply list:

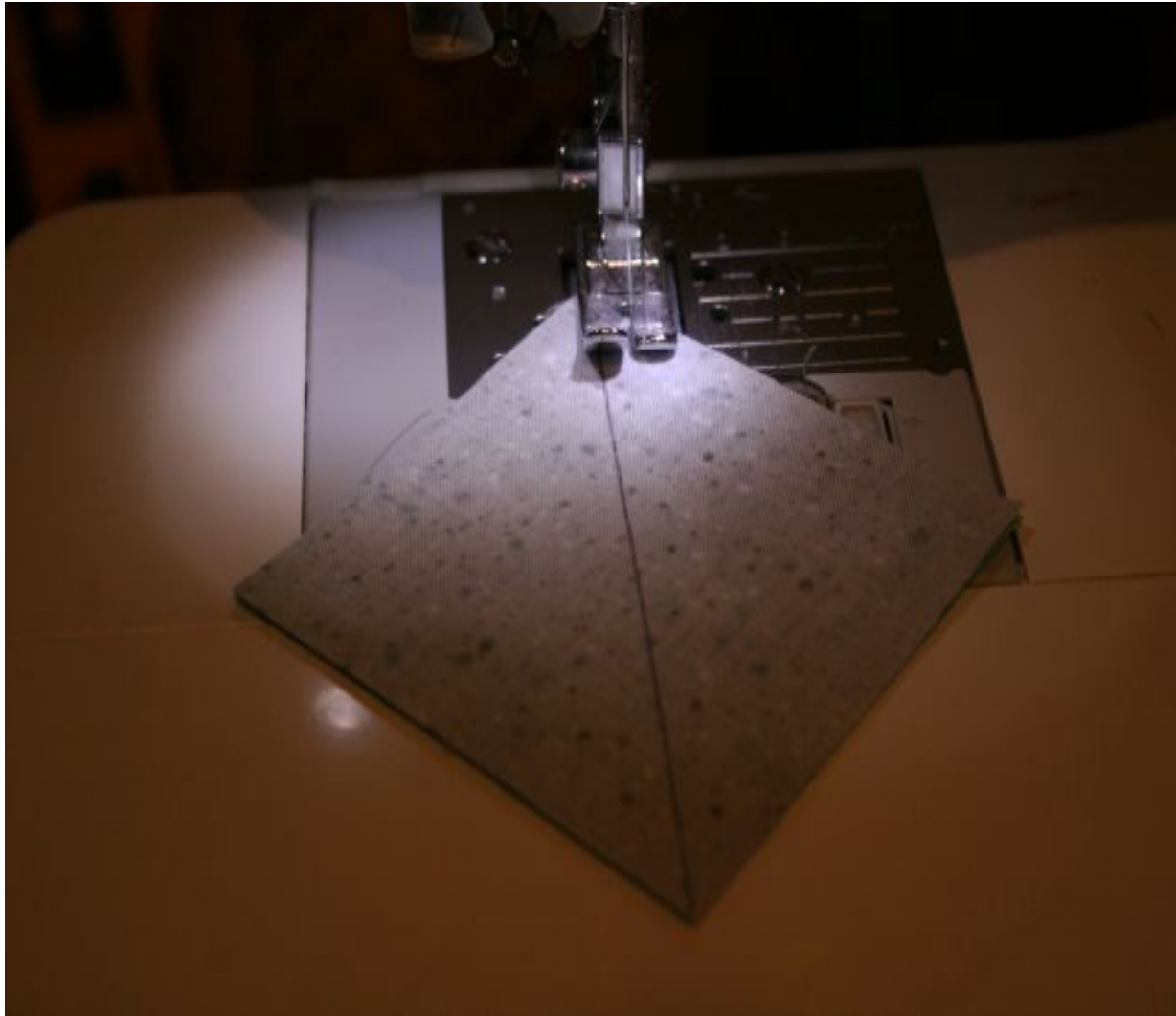
All of Color 3 and Color
4 3" squares

Step 1

Put right sides together and draw a line diagonal on the lighter fabric. Do this for all your color 3 and 4.



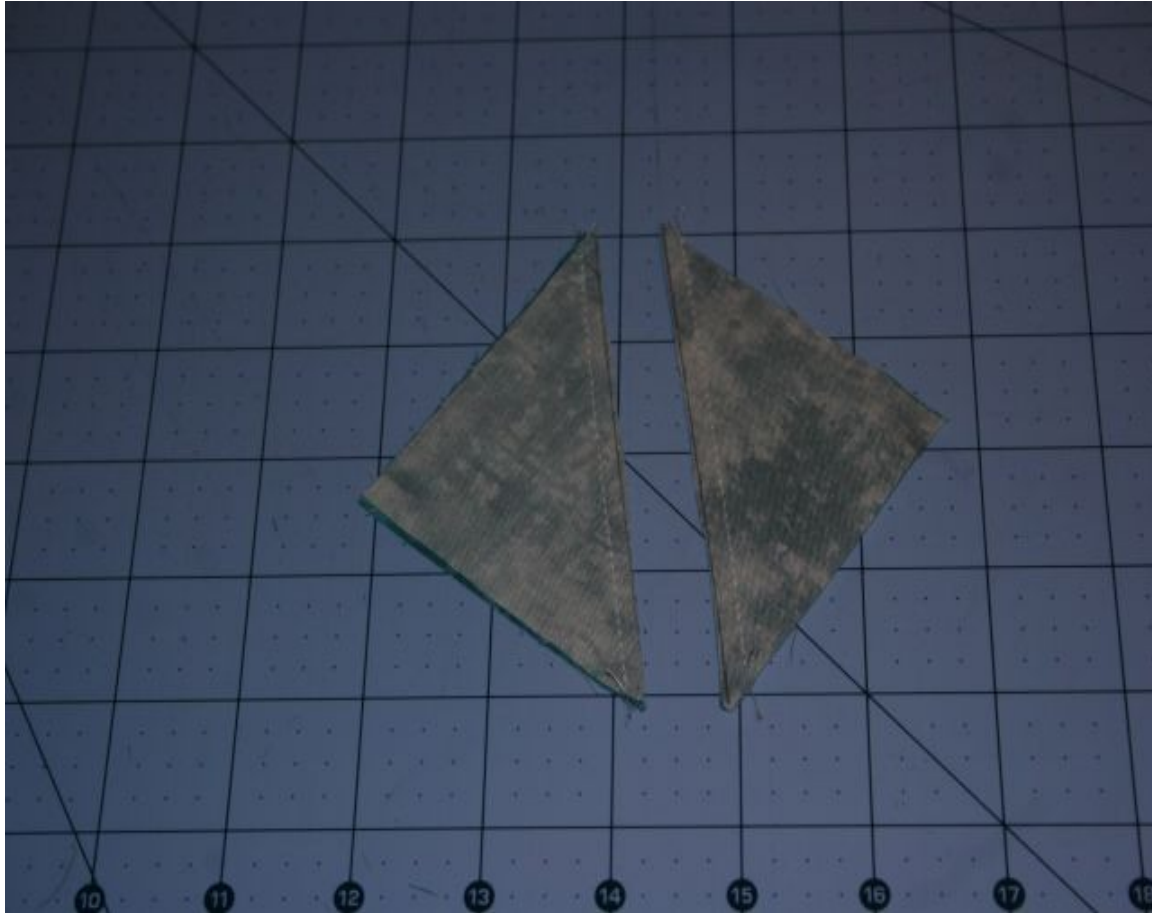
Step 2



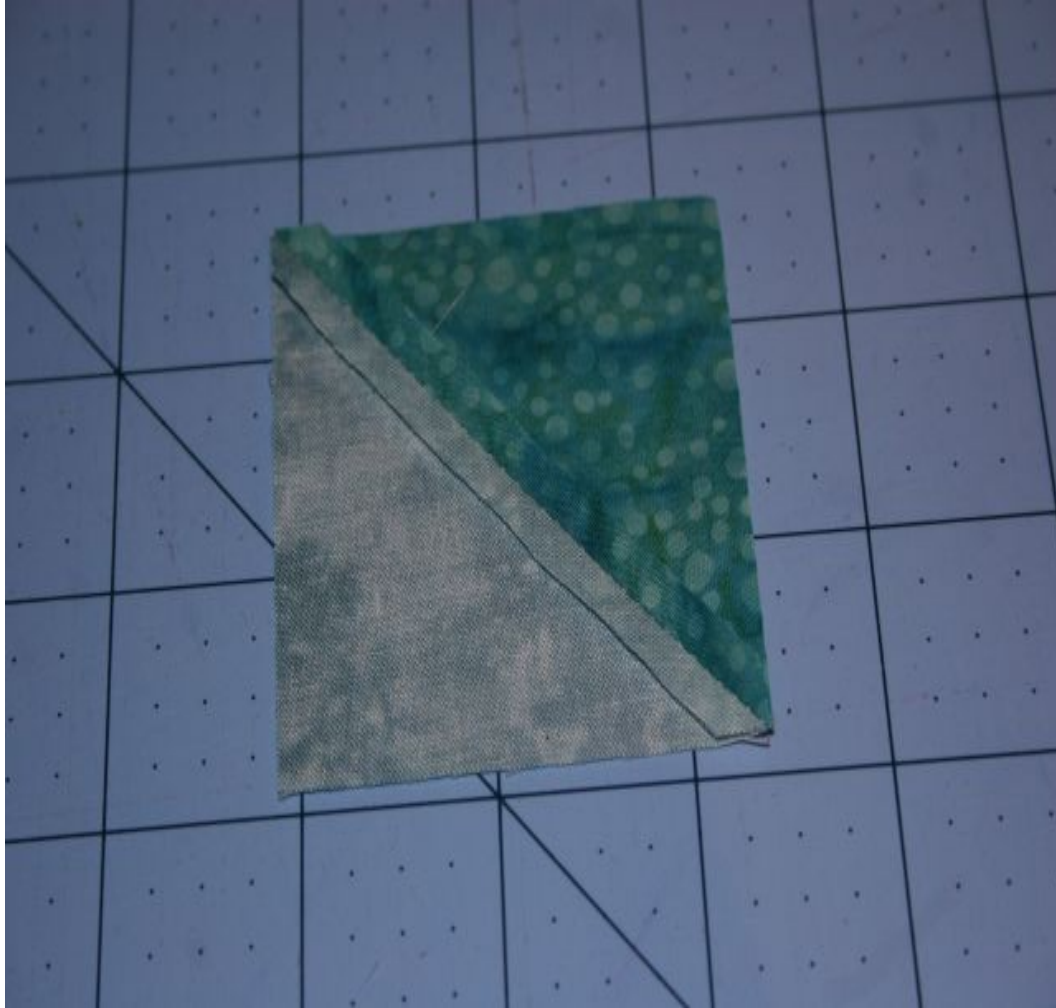
Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the line. Do this for all the squares.

Step 3

Cut apart on the drawn line.

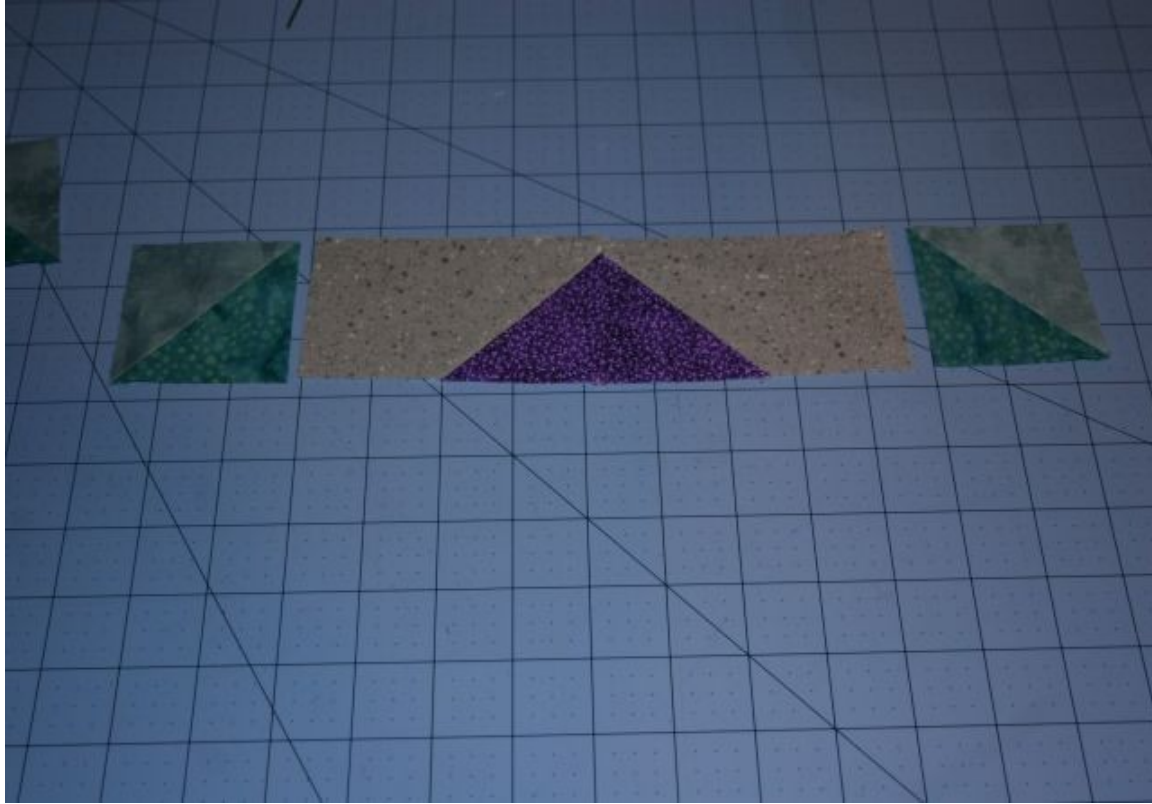


Step4



These half squares we are going to iron OPEN This way it will be easier on the construction later on.

Clue 5a

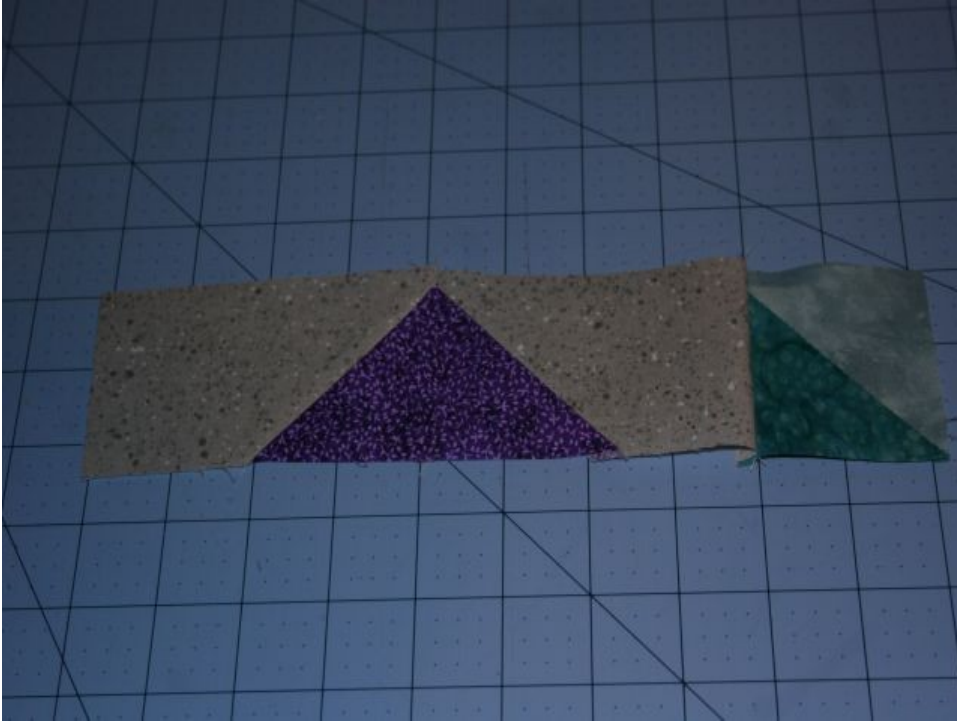


Supplies:

All of Clue 5 Halfsquares.

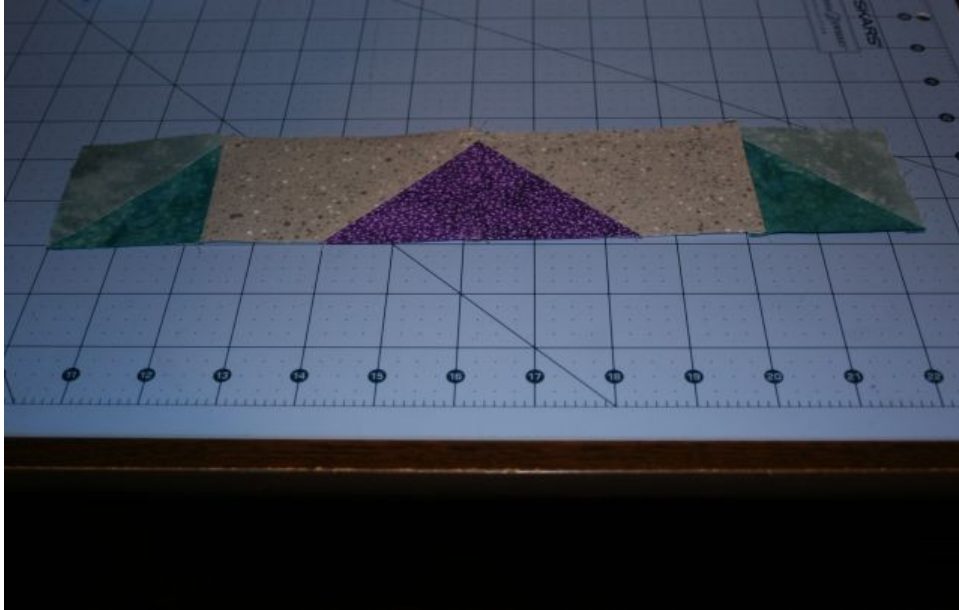
All of the remaining Clue 1 pieces.

Step 1



Sew a clue 5 half square to a Clue 1 rectangle. Do this for all your pieces.

Step 2



Sew another half square on the other side of Clue 1 rectangle. Do this for all remaining pieces.

Construction Time!



This is the layout for the first row.

Step 1



2nd Row Layout. Watch the first block, it is going in the other direction.. it's on purpose wait and see.

Step 3

Third Row Layout



Step 4

Fourth Row! One more for a Crib size..



Step 5



Fifth Row. Now that all the rows are done we need to sew them together..
1,2,3,4,and 5. (This will depend on what size you do.)

Finished!!
